#### 4.4 August Mexico Americas Down Syndrome Games

With Jose Costa Pereira and Carla Cardoso, from DSISO, I returned for the Americas Games for athletes with Down syndrome. We were able to give Technical support to the three sports in the Games, Athletics, Swimming and Table Tennis.

#### 4.5 September Trisome Games Inspection

With the Technical Directors for some of the Sports I travelled to Antalya to inspect the Sports Provisions for the Trisome Games. I also met with the LOC and some of the Technical Committee that were organising this event.

#### 4.6 December Portugal IB21 and JUDOWN

My final visit of 2019 was to Guimarães in Portugal for the IBA21 and JUDOWN Open European Championships
